Mudjacking Versus Polyfoam


INJECTION PROCESS FOR POLYURETHANE INJECTION



Two parts of the polyurethane foam travel down a set of hoses separately and mix in the nozzle. They pass through the port and slab in liquid form.



Foam finds low spots and expands in all directions. After approximately six seconds a reaction occurs, expanding into weak soils, compacting, consolidating and increasing density. The foam will expand completely in approximately 15 seconds.



DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MUDJACKING & POLYFOAM

Mudjacking and polyurethane foam injection are similar in that they inject material under a slab to fill voids.

POLYURETHANE FOAM	MUDJACKING
5/8th" diameter holes	1 to 1 5/8th" diameter holes
Uses water resistant two part poly foam	Uses cement "slurry"
Cures in 15 minutes	Cures in 1-2 days
